Hello,

Thank you for submitting a notice of exemption for accessible voting machine on behalf of King County, which was received in our office on August 5, 2025. Your notice states your political subdivision is seeking an exemption from the requirement to have accessible voting systems available in every polling place during the November 4, 2025 election. Our office has reviewed your notice.

Your county has a population of 265 as per the 2020 Census. Therefore, you are allowed to use the exemption available to counties with a population less than 2,000.

A voter with a disability that desires a reasonable accommodation to vote in your election shall make a request for the accommodation with the early voting clerk not later than the 21st day before the date of the election. On receipt of the request, the early voting clerk shall make a reasonable accommodation to allow the voter to cast a vote.

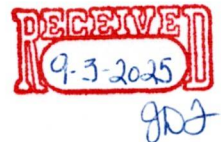
